Snow Removal Protocol

Snow on the sidewalks will be plowed to the street with plow trucks and pushed to the center of the road. A box plow will come to push the snow to the end of the streets or designated piles. Once normal plowing is complete, we will clear mail-boxes and fire hydrants. For snow storage we will use overflow parking and the golf course area. Pathways by the club-house will be cleared with a walk-behind snow blower. For post plowing cleanup following storm days, we will first clean up the main drag piles and then prioritize cleaning up piles in accordance with the safety of the entire community.

When we will or won't plow:

- We will not plow until we have a minimum of two to three inches of snow.
- We will not plow if we have two to three inches and it's turning to rain or warm temperatures.
- We will not plow if we have two to three inches of accumulation and the storm is a few hours from ending.
- We will plow mid-storm if we have a minimum of five to six inches of accumulation.
- Morning plows will start at 5:00 a.m. if the storm is complete.

What we need you to do:

- If possible on snowy days, keep garbage cans off the sidewalks until 11:00 a.m. or until plowed.
- ***** Vehicles in the overflow parking areas must be parked in the middle parking spots.
- * Be careful and mindful of snow plows while they are out working.

These are the guidelines we will use, but protocols may vary based on weather conditions.
